WATER ADVISORY BOARD

Water Advisory Board (WAB)

The Broward Water Advisory Board’s purpose is to advise and make recommendations to the Broward County Board of Commissioners in matters relating to the development, use and management of water resources within Broward County which may include, but are not limited to, water supply, water conservation, ground water recharge, reuse of wastewater effluent, and stormwater management. The [15 member Water Advisory Board](#) is supported by two committees and meets [every other month](#)

Technical Advisory Board (TAC)

The [TAC’s 26 members](#) include water managers, utility directors, business interests, and representatives from state agencies, providing technical support and analysis to the Water Advisory Board. The purpose of the TAC is to provide technical expertise from a diverse group of water managers, school district, state agencies, and business interests.

Surface Water Coordinating Committee (SWCC)

The Surface Water Coordinating Committee members consist of drainage and water control district and government water managers that meet quarterly to discuss issues of mutual interest and concern. Two members also serve on the Technical Advisory Committee. The purpose of the Surface Water Coordinating Committee is to encourage all water control districts, municipalities and regional water managers to participate in surface water resources management and to assist in surface water efficiency for Broward County.
